**PILGRIM 2:** This advent Baba is one of the first Avatars to ever go all over the world. Maybe next advent He'll have to go out to space.

**ERUCH:** Go out of space. That's why the space ships are now making ready for that. Yeah it is. Because I still remember.

**PILGRIM 1:** [crosstalk] what the New life will be [pilgrims laughing].

**ERUCH:** I still remember [pilgrims laughing]. What will be the New Life will

be it is from earth to space? [Eruch laughs] The New life.

**PILGRIM 2:** Sorry I interrupted you. What were you saying?

**ERUCH:** No what I was saying is that He told us this also but see how the inventions have taken place. And with what rapidity they have taken place. And it appears as if man is so intelligent to invent so many things and think of such things. But who is at the bottom of it? Why do they do it? "It is because I have to use these things. I had to make use of these, so in preparation for that they have given this to the world."

**BARBARA:** You said, you mean the scientific discoveries?

**ERUCH:** Yeah. For His work. All the. Take for instance the plane. Then He quoted, "Take for instance the plane. How would it be if the plane had not been? Because that makes me go from one place to another in no time. Come back again," and so forth.

**PILGRIM 3:** That's why we need the positive sense.

**ERUCH:** The positive sense is simple He said. People in the world think that. Because they used to ask this question, put this question to Baba and says, "Baba if there is God, why did God permit such a thing? You say that you are God in human form and how can it be that your presence in the world is here and you allow such. You permitted such catastrophe this holocaust." And so Baba said with a deep sigh says, "Should I tell you the truth? Do you want to know? What do you make out of this Holocaust?" "Well tremendous suffering. Mankind crying out. **ERUCH:** Yeah.

**VINOO:** Really chosen for that.

**ERUCH:** It seems so.

**VINOO:** Because intense suffering means.

**ERUCH:** Intense suffering is closeness and proximity to Him. That is the thing.

**VINOO:** Due to Baba only [inaudible] intense suffering. It's a gift.

**ERUCH:** Yeah. But Vinoobai these people don't take it like that that it's a gift you see when they suffer. [crosstalk]. "As soon as we come to Baba we come to know Baba there is terrible suffering in our house [pilgrims laughing]. How could He be the one who loves us?" they say. And now what to answer? And if we were to answer [crosstalk]. Huh?

**VINOO:** See the life of Mirabai.

**ERUCH:** What is that tell? [crosstalk].

**VINOO:** How she suffered.

**ERUCH:** See how it is yes.

**VINOO:** Because she had love for Baba.

**ERUCH:** Yeah, yeah.

**VINOO:** That was the only reason she

suffered.

**ERUCH:** What Mira, Mira. The great lover of the Lord. She suffered to the degree where her husband who was a prince threatened her and lot of things were done to her to stop this nonsense of her taking the name of the Lord and singing His praise and dancing on the streets and all that. "Do you realise what you are? You are of the royal family and how come that you go on dancing like that and singing on the street like that?" You know it's amongst Indian women you know how it is. **ERUCH:** Oh I didn't have breakfast, I didn't have good sleep tonight I'm suffering from insomnia [clock chimes] [pilgrims laughing]. This is modern age suffering. Insomnia, hunger, constipation, headache [general laughter]. Pardon?

**VINOO:** In one of her songs she had described this. So this is her authentic state. She has described this incident. Her songs are even now heard.

**ERUCH:** Yeah. Are sung by all in the country.

**BARBARA:** Was she at the time of Krishna?

**ERUCH:** No, no.
